

TRAIN THE TRAINERS PROGRAMME



Trauma-Informed Care Training Using the Safety, Stability, Repair and Resilience (SSRR) Approach

By becoming a trainer in Trauma-Informed Care Training Using the SSRR Approach (TIC SSRR), participants will learn how to deliver the 2-day TIC SSRR Training and a 1-day advanced TIC Course within their own service. Candidates who have been selected by their own service must attend one TIC SSRR course prior to full completion of the Train the Trainer Programme (this can be undertaken as part of the Train the Trainer course delivery – see Pathway 1). Following completion of the programme, candidates will be observed delivering a TIC SSRR course within their own service. The TIC SSRR Training the Trainer Programme is usually held online, and is delivered between 9:00am – 4:30pm.

Course Delivery

Key benefits of the becoming a Trainer in trauma-informed care include:

- Thinking in terms of what has happened to a child, rather than 'What is wrong with them?'
- Understanding that "behaviours"/ "symptoms" are adaptive
- Helping children to own their own story
- Understanding how past trauma influences present
- Accepting that trauma is common between all of us
- Understanding that power and context are crucial to being trauma informed
- Recognising that kindness, compassion and relationships are key
- Avoiding doing further harm

Course Delivery

Pathway 1 (For candidates who have not previously completed Trauma-Informed Care Training Using the SSRR Approach - includes the delivery of prerequisite training)

Duration: 11.5 days

Delivery: Virtual (face-to-face training will incur additional expenses)

Cost: £2,500 per person plus VAT*

Pathway 2 (For candidates who have already attended the pre-requisite course):

Duration: 8.5 days

Delivery: Virtual (face-to-face training will incur additional expenses)

Cost: £1,845 per person plus VAT*

The cost (*subject to change depending on delivery requirements and annual review) includes all course materials and trainer's notes, plus observation and feedback upon first delivery of the course. Participants who successfully complete the training are also required to attend 6-monthly continuing professional development (CPD) days over a two-year period.

Annual Licensing Fee

After year one there is an annual licence fee, which includes registration onto our certified trainers register, attendance at 2 virtual CPD days, and 2 hours of mentoring/supervision each year.
